Australia is reopening and we can't wait to have you join us for full on campus learning in 2022.

The Australian government recently announced that fully vaccinated students can travel to Australia without a travel exemption. This means all students will be able to join us here in Melbourne ready for the start of the 2022 first semester.

It's exciting news for students outside of Australia who have endured many months of uncertainty due to travel restrictions. It's also wonderful news for our local students and staff

who have missed the vibrant community created by the many international students on campus.

What does this mean for students travelling to Australia?

There will be some requirements for travellers to Melbourne (such as being fully vaccinated with an approved vaccine, and returning a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to travel), however our expectation is that all international students will be here on campus from the start of 2022.

What do I need to do now?

If you have received an offer from Swinburne and you're planning to join us, now is the time to make sure you've got everything ready for your arrival.

We'll work with you every step of the way to help prepare for your studies. For now, it's important we understand whether you are coming to Melbourne for our first-half intakes. This includes courses commencing in Semester 1, Pathways intake 1, and ELICOS intake 1.
