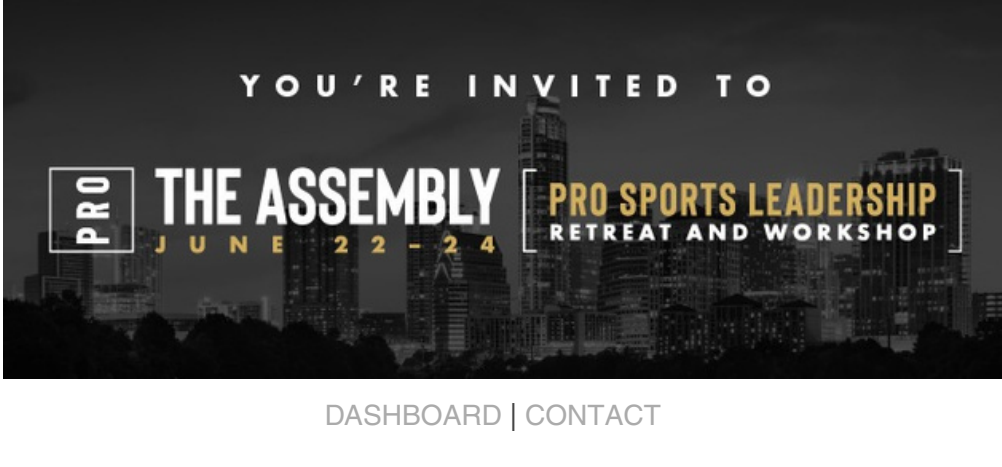

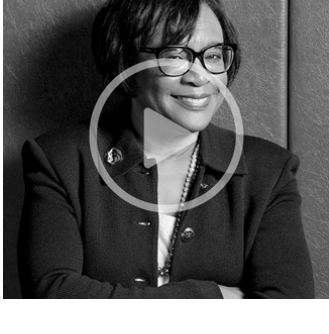
## LEARN ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

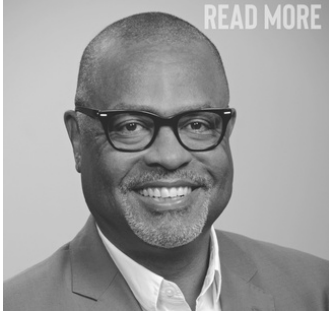
### Get to Know Cynt Marshall
