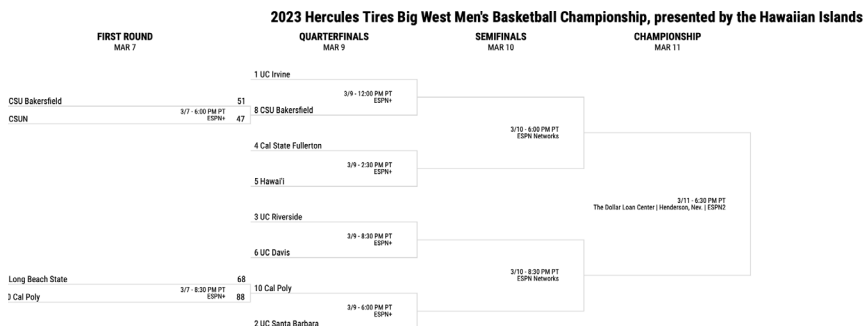

HEAD COACH MIKE MAGPAYO

Mike Magpayo has set a new standard for UC Riverside men's basketball in his short time at the head of the program, completing his first full year at the helm after the 2021-22 year. Magpayo was named interim head coach for the 2020-21 season, then was promoted to full-time head coach on May 21, 2021.

A recipient of the Rising Coaches Trailblazer Award, an award presented to individuals who have blazed the way for diversity, equity and inclusion through the coaching and sports industry, Magpayo led UCR to a six seed in the Big West Tournament and a 16-12 season with wins over previously-unbeaten Hawaii and Cal State Fullerton on ESPNU, and a memorable

buzzer-beating win at Arizona State during the season's opening weekend that made the rounds through the college basketball world.

Magpayo's program garnered four All-Big West spots for the second consecutive year, including Dominick Pickett picking up All-Big West Honorable Mention honors and a second straight Best Hustle Player award.

Before the 2020-21 year, Magpayo had served as an assistant coach with the program since his arrival prior to the 2017-18 season.

Following his first year at the helm, Magpayo led the program to new heights in the 2020-21 season with its highest Big West Tournament seed in program history (three) and the first Big West Tournament win in 10 years. The 2020-21 Highlanders also posted the best Big West record in since the 2008-09 season, doing so in four fewer games.

UCR's 57-42 win over Washington marked a number of firsts for Magpayo, including his first over a signature Power-5 opponent. It was his first win as a head coach, his first game coached on the sideline, and further, the first win for a team coached by a Division I head coach of Asian American descent.

For his efforts, Magpayo was named the 2021 Joe B. Hall Award recipient, given annually to the top first-year head coach in Division I college basketball.

He was promoted to Associate Head Coach after a 2019-20 season when he helped lead the program to a record-tying 17 wins. As defensive coordinator, Magpayo was able to push the 2019-20 Highlanders to the top of multiple national rankings defensively, including ranking in the top 10 in scoring defense, field goal percentage and defensive rebounding on their way to invitations to both the CBI and CIT.

Prior to arriving in Riverside, he spent a year as the men's basketball director of operations at the University of San Francisco on the staff his coaching mentor, Kyle Smith. The Dons finished the season with 22 wins, a fourth-place finish in the West Coast Conference and an appearance in CBI Championship.

Prior to his time at San Francisco, Magpayo spent three seasons at Campbell University in the Big South Conference, where he served as the defensive coordinator and recruiting coordinator. In 2016-17, he helped put together one of the best seasons in school history, as the Camels advanced to the conference championship game as well as the CIT quarterfinals in the program's first postseason appearance since 1992. While at Campbell, Magpayo recruited and developed current Houston Rockets guard Chris Clemons.

A Hacienda Heights, Calif. native, Magpayo was the lead recruiter at Columbia for Ivy Player of the year Maodo Lo from Germany as well as 6'11 all league player Luke Petrusek. He was also an integral part in helping bring Columbia to new heights, serving as director of operations, assistant coach, and recruiting coordinator and scheduler during the most successful four-year run in Columbia history 2010-14.

Magpayo has also found tremendous success off the court, both as the CEO of a multi-million dollar real estate firm in Southern California for seven years, and as the founder and president of the Asian Coaches Association. He graduated from UC Santa Barbara with a degree in business economics in 2001. He was also a Southern California High School basketball coach from 2001-2010 before starting his college coaching career.

Magpayo resides in Riverside with his wife Caroline, who is a UC Riverside alumna, class of 2011.

NOTES

ANYONE, ANYWHERE, ANYTIME

UCR has built a habit on testing itself among the top tier of men's college basketball, talking their talk with a current three-game win streak against the Power 5 that includes last year's viral buzzer beater at Arizona State. New Year's Eve's comeback win at Long Beach State - a place where UCR had historically struggled - was two games removed from the end of a non-conference slate designed to prepare the Highlanders for Big West play.

HASHTAG HIGHLANDERS: WHAT'S/WHO'S TRENDING

- UCR is 15-1 when leading with five minutes remaining after being up by two at the five minute mark of last Thursday's win over Hawaii.
- UC Riverside is 9-2 in Big West games decided by single digits.
- UC Riverside is 10-1 in conference play when **Jamal Hartwell II**, who averaged 10.2 points per game in Big West play, shoots at least 50 percent from the floor. The Highlanders are also unbeaten when Hartwell goes for over 50 percent from downtown.
- UCR's magic number this year is 70. UC Riverside is 12-3 this year when holding opponents under 70 points and 17-2 themselves when scoring 70 or more.
- UC Riverside is 12-5 when assisting on at least 50 percent of their field goals. UCR ranks fourth in Big West play with 13.37 assists per game.
- UCR is 6-2 when going north of 40 rebounds in a game.
- **Flynn Cameron** has hit a three in all but three of UCR's games this season, and averaged a conference-leading 2.7 triples per game in conference play. Cameron ran point for the Highlanders in **Zyon Pullin's** absence, a role he held at this summer's FIBA Asia Cup.

PUT SOME RESPECT ON OUR NAME

Zyon Pullin's Player of the Week win last Monday set another benchmark for UC Riverside men's basketball with a program-record fifth Big West weekly honor in a season. It was the second straight week a Highlander has earned the honor after **Flynn Cameron** won it last week, when Cameron was also named CollegelInsider's Lou Henson National Player of the Week, the second time this season UCR has won the award after **Pullin's** performance at the Vegas 4 back in November. UC Riverside leads the conference with five Big West weekly honors this season and is one of four schools with multiple such awards.

RAISE THE RIV

The Highlanders have collected benchmark wins both in and out of conference in what continues to be a UCR team making headwaves across the mid-major college basketball landscape. Among other accolades, UCR has achieved...

- 20 wins for the first time in program history, five Big West Players of the Week and 10 Big West victories
- The third-most points in a UCR Division I game with a 96-76 win over CSUN
- A second season sweep of UC Davis in the last three years, the first season sweep of Long Beach State since 2008-09 and the first ever sweep of UC Santa Barbara
- Six wins this when being down by at least 10 at any point, including four in Big West play (Long Beach State, CSU Bakersfield, UC San Diego twice, Hawaii).
- Three wins at the Vegas 4 against mid-majors who all eclipsed 20 wins last season
- The program's first-ever win at UC Santa Barbara and fifth and sixth-ever wins against Long Beach State. Entering this season, UC Riverside was a combined 4-50 on the road against the Beach and Gauchos. This year's team picked up both road wins not even halfway through the Big West schedule.

AWARD SEASON

UC Riverside cleaned up in the postseason Big West men's basketball awards. **Mike Magpayo** was named the Big West Coach of the Year, the first such award in program history and the second conference Coach of the Year award this academic year for UCR (Tim Cupello, men's soccer), in addition to being named a finalist for the Hugh Durham award, presented by CollegelInsider to the top mid-major head coach in Division I men's college basketball. Elsewhere in specialty awards, **Lachlan Olbrich** was named the Big West Freshman of the Year after finishing as the only freshman to rank in the top five in Big West play in rebounding and field goal percentage, while **Jamal Hartwell II** was named the Sixth Man of the Year. **Zyon Pullin** and **Flynn Cameron** were named to the First and Second Teams, respectively.

LET IT FLY

UCR is second the conference with a 36.9 percent clip in conference play, leads the Big West with 8.4 made threes per outing and is third with a 31.5 percent three-point defense. **Flynn Cameron** leads the Big West with a 43.3 percent three-point clip and 2.3 made threes per game.

RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

Flynn Cameron and **Zyon Pullin** are putting up record numbers from both a career and season standpoint this season. Both are in the top seven in the program's Division I history in assists in a season, while Pullin is the fifth Highlander at the Division I level to log 3,000 career minutes. Out on the perimeter, Cameron surpassed Dominic Pickett's place in the Highlanders' Division I career three-point list and enters the Big West Championships fourth with 169 threes in a UCR uniform. Pullin is also 15 assists shy of becoming UCR's new all-time assists leader, passing Reggie Mims (1973-76).

BALL (DISTRIBUTION) IS LIFE

UC Riverside ranks fourth in the Big West with 13.25 assists per game and also fourth with 265 overall, thanks to **Flynn Cameron** and **Zyon Pullin** combining for 137 of those in conference play. Both rank in the top seven in Division I single-season history, and Pullin ranks fourth in single-season assists in the Highlanders' D1 era.

SUCCESS UNDER MAGPAYO

The **Mike Magpayo** coaching era for UC Riverside has seen milestone after milestone, as the Highlanders have continued to raise the standard for UCR men's basketball with him on staff - both as a head coach and assistant coach.

- UCR's win over Washington on December 1, 2020 was the first win at the NCAA Men's Division I level by a head coach of Asian American descent.
- The Highlanders have now claimed season sweeps over UC Davis, Long Beach State and UC Santa Barbara in the same season.
- UCR has won 25 Big West games since the start of the 2020-21 season, Magpayo's first as head coach. The program needed the previous five seasons to reach 25 conference victories, and Magpayo is the fastest UCR head coach to 25 Big West victories.
- Three of UCR's most recent wins over Power 5 schools have come with Magpayo on staff: 2019-20 at Nebraska, 2020-21 vs. Washington, 2021-22 at Arizona State.
- December 11's win over Idaho improved UC Riverside to 6-3 for just the fourth time in the program's 22-year Division I history and second in three years.
- UCR has also shot up the national rankings in the defensive rebounding category under Magpayo, going from 75th in 2019-20 to 36th in his first year as head coach in 2020-21.
- UC Riverside reached 12 wins in the month of January for just the third time in the program's 22-year Division I history, including twice now with Magpayo on staff (2015-16, 2019-20, 2022-23).

VIVA LAS VEGAS

UC Riverside scored an impressive non-conference sweep of the Vegas 4 in November with wins over Weber State, Abilene Christian and Wright State, all of whom reached 20 wins last season. UCR assisted on at least 50 percent of its field goals in all three contests, and **Zyon Pullin** earned CollegeInsider National Player of the Week while **Flynn Cameron** earned Big West Player of the Week.

TRANSFER TOWN, CA

The Highlanders have brought 12 Division I transfers through the program dating back to the 2016-17 season. **Kyle Owens** (Montana), **Jamal Hartwell II** (George Mason) and **Luke Turner** (Wofford) join the Highlanders in 2022-23 alongside fellow D1 transplants **Flynn Cameron** (DePaul) and **Jhaylon Martinez** (UNLV). SoCal natives Turner, Owens and Hartwell were recruited by Magpayo out of high school.

TIES TO THE ASSOCIATION

- **Kobe Jerome** is the younger brother of former Virginia national champion and current Golden State Warriors guard Ty Jerome - the duo worked out at Columbia back when Magpayo was an assistant with the Lions' program.
- Last year's buzzer beater at Arizona State was spurred by a motivational pregame speech from Suns guard Chris Paul, a close friend of former Highlander JP Moorman II.
- **Mike Magpayo** has looked to Miami Heat head coach Eric Spoelstra for guidance and mentorship over the years as a trailblazer of Asian American coaches on the sideline.
- **Zyon Pullin** was one of 21 Division I college players to serve as a counselor at Damian Lillard's inaugural Formula Zero camp this summer. Dame gave Pullin a Twitter shoutout after the senior guard eclipsed 1,000 career points against San Diego.

UCR pulled out the two-point win in Davis on Zyon Pullin's driving layup with just seconds left - his first game back after a five-game absence - before securing a seven-point win in Riverside on February 9.

6 Lachlan Olbrich was one of six players and the only freshman to rank in the top six in Big West play in rebounding (4th/6.8) and field goal percentage (5th/.468).
