Children with ASD often have problems with social, emotional, and communication skills. Signs of ASD begin during early childhood and typically last throughout a person's life Children with ASD might show

 Have trouble expressing their needs using typical words or motions

 Not play "pretend" games (for example, notpretend to "feed" a doil)

 Repeat actions over and over again
- Have unusual reactions to the way things smell, taste, look, feel, or sound
- Lose skills they once had (for example, stop saying words they were once using)
