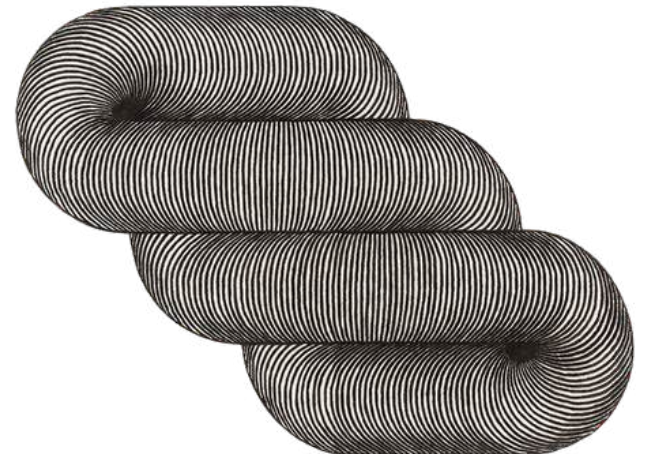

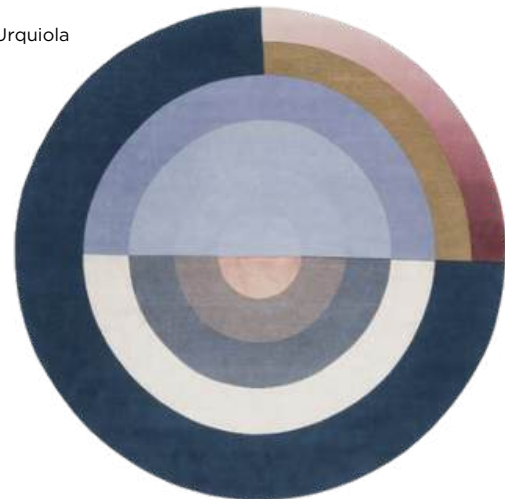

The Color Wheel

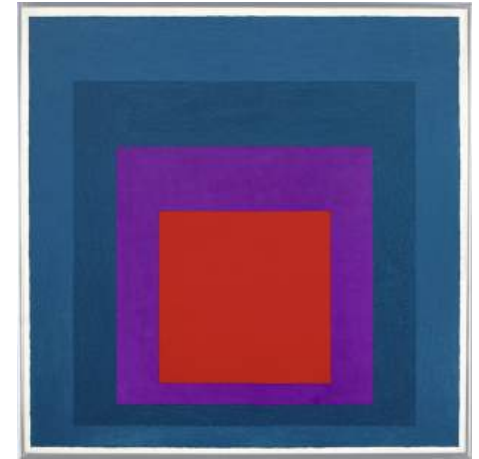

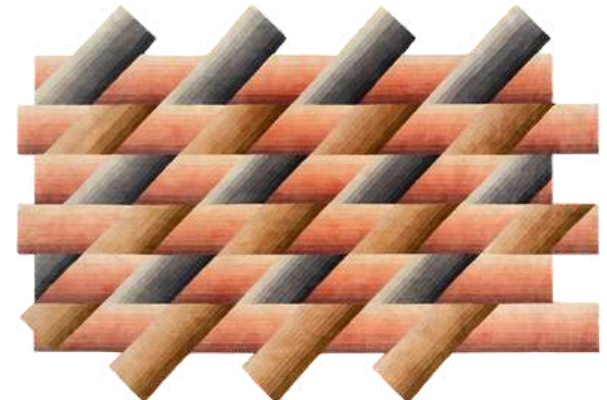
