Avoid pressure washing your roof, as it can strip away the roofing granules that protect your roof shingles.

### Summer Shingle Roof Maintenance Tasks

Summer heat and UV exposure can cause shingles to curl, crack, or dry out. This is the time to focus on ventilation and heat-related wear.

#### 1. Inspect for Warping or Cracked Shingles

Take a look at your roof on a clear day (or call us for a quick inspection to assess shingle damage). High temperatures can cause shingles to buckle, and damaged shingles can't properly protect your roof from moisture.

#### 2. Check Attic Ventilation

Your attic needs to breathe, especially in the hot summer months. Poor ventilation can trap heat, leading to higher cooling costs and premature aging of your shingles.
