New Catalog Experience Coming in September 2023

Warren-Newport Public Library is joining Cooperative Computer Services (CCS), a group of 29 area libraries that share an online catalog and member database. WNPL cardholders will have access to materials from CCS member libraries including Fremont, Grayslake, Lake Villa, and Round Lake, along with many others, with the added convenience of picking up and dropping off materials at our library. Over two million resources were shared across the CCS network of libraries in 2020-2021, which serves as a tremendous example of the diversity and wealth of titles available to patrons through the library network.

- WNPL cards will automatically be registered at all CCS libraries
- WNPL patrons will be able to view local collection items along with items in all CSS libraries' collections
- Items from CCS libraries' collections will be available for pick up at WNPL
- Patrons can pick up and return most items to any CCS library

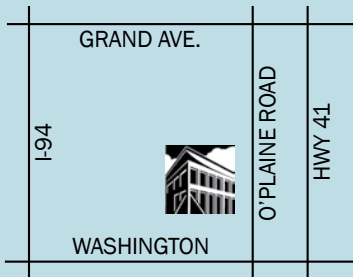
